

WALKING TOUR - SEA SHORE - LA JOLLA October 19, 2021

Meet 10:30 AM - Depart 11:00 AM

We are planning a walking tour of the most popular part of La Jolla, its sea shore. La Jolla gets about one million visitors per year and all tend to gather at this area. The main attraction is the sea lions; Point La Jolla is the largest mainland sea lion rookery in California. The pupping season ends in October. Other points of interest are the children's pool where the seals are pupping, the large Scripps Park, La Jolla Cove and the rugged shore with hundreds of cormorants and pelicans. The walk is easy and flat and will last about one hour with stops. Due to its popularity it is almost impossible to find parking in this area. Therefore we ask everyone to carpool. The walk starts at 11:00 AM at the children's pool opposite Casa de Manana. Please arrive before 10:30. For those who do not find close parking we have a plan B. Unload your people at the children's pool gazebo and park your car at the Recreation Center on Draper and Prospect. Parking there is available but limited to two hours. Harry Stovall will take the drivers back to the children's pool and after the walk take them back to the Recreation Center. If you are so inclined you also can park and walk from there. After the walk we plan to have lunch in La Jolla.
