There also will be a non-refundable cancellation fee for all cancellations whether or not your spot is filled as follows: \$10.00 for trips up to \$100.00; \$20.00 for trips \$100.00 - \$300.00; \$35.00 for trips above \$300.00. There will be an additional \$20.00 charge for any returned checks.


