TRIP RULES

- 1. CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS: In the event of your cancellation, a refund will be made only if the seat vacancy is filled or if monies are recovered by the club. There also will be a non-refundable cancellation fee for all cancellations whether or not your spot is filled as follows: \$10.00 for trips up to \$100.00; \$20.00 for trips \$100.00 \$300.00; \$35.00 for trips above \$300.00. There will be an additional \$20.00 charge for any returned checks.

- 2. CHECKS: Checks will be destroyed for those not going on the event due to being on a wait list.


