North City Water Reclamation Plant - 4949 Eastgate Mall

We have been here before but there are many changes and improvements.

Pure Water San Diego is the City's phased, multi-year program that will provide one-third of our water supply. The program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe drinking water. Having a tour is a great way to learn about the water purification process. The tour will include a presentation and a walking tour of the facility. Find out how the City plans to use technology to produce our water supply and at the end of the tour a chance to sample the purified water.

A security guard will meet you at the gate. Name must be on list and you will need to show your photo ID.
