You will see where training occurs for 52 different law enforcement agencies from throughout California; from recruits in the academy to the SWAT teams and the K9 units. The tour will include the following: Dog Demonstration - Actual deputies will be training with their canines. See how the dogs take down a suspect. Vetra Demonstration -

This is a computerized threat recognition and assessment system. - Duffy Town-This is a scenario training area.

There also will be a non-refundable cancellation fee for all cancellations whether or not your spot is filled as follows: \$10.00 for trips up to \$100.00; \$20.00 for trips \$100.00 \$300.00; \$35.00 for trips above \$300.00.
