WIND TUNNEL TOUR - Free Thursday, September 7 - Meet 9:45 AM - Tour Starts - 10:00 AM Limited to 20 People - MEMBERS ONLY

The Convair Low Speed Wind Tunnel began Operations in May 1947, located at the airport. In March 2006, San Diego Air & Space Museum acquired the Wind Tunnel. The facility is now known as the San Diego Air & Space Technology Center. The tunnel is commonly referred to as the San Diego Wind Tunnel. Aeronautics, sports – athletes and equipment, alternative energy devices and any project which needs to withstand high winds are tested at the Tunnel. The tour takes 20 - 40 minutes and provides insight to one of San Diego's remaining and still operative WWII era buildings. This 70 year old building is **not ADA compliant** and **steep sets of stairs provide access** to various parts of the facility. **WALKING SHOES ARE A MUST.** Group Lunch if interested after the tour.

Directions: go south on Pacific Hwy from Washington or Sassafras St. Enter the parking lot through the open double gates on the south side of the building. 
